Nose: Chic and elegant. Warm seductive aromas of honeyed pear and milk chocolate are wrapped in beautiful Amoroso Sherry wood from the noble House of Gonzalez Byass, Jerez de la Frontera, Spain. As you would expect attractive scents of crushed almonds citrus fruits, bergamot and warm berries linger in the background. A perfect balance prevails.

Taste: Pure Heaven. The nose is reflected on the taste, only this time whispers of cherry, plum then mandarin begin to emerge but these delightful flavours quickly give way to freshly baked bread, caramelised peaches and apricots. The long years in aromatic American white oak have crafted its sweet soul.

The finesse for 18 months in finest amoroso sherry wood have nurtured its complex and spicy character. The warmth of your tongue is needed to tease out its true personality. Never hurry it. Take your time. You will not be disappointed.
